- 2. Applicant should preferably be below the age of 38 years as on January 01, 2024, but age limit can be relaxed to 40 years for the candidates with exceptional merit. Proof of age must be submitted with the application.
- 3. Applicant should be a Life Member of IRIA. If the applicant is also a member of 'Indian College of Radiology & Imaging', then additional credit will be awarded while considering for the medal.
- 4. The applicant should submit the application on or before 30th September 2024 through online portal, which is available on the website of IRIA <u>www.iria.org.in</u>.

Details of academic contributions made only in the year 2023 in any of the methods as mentioned in the marking guidelines on the portal will be considered by the Credential Committee.
