Eligibility Guidelines and Requirements of Orations of IRIA

Eligibility

- (i) The applicant should be a Life Member of IRIA for IRIA Orations.
- (ii) Applications for IRIA Orations should be proposed & seconded by IRIA Emeritus/Life Members.

Requirements

- 1. The title and abstract of Oration should be submitted along with application.
- 2. The work presented should be personal contribution of the applicant preferably done in India.
- 3. The subject of the Oration should not have been published or presented elsewhere.
- 4. The application should be submitted within the time limit (on or before 30th September) through online portal along with all necessary documents as proof.
- 5. The IRIA Oration shall be held on the 2nd Day of the Annual Conference of IRIA. The Oration shall not exceed 30 minutes reading time.
- 6. As per constitution, a member can apply for one Oration at one time, either in IRIA or in ICRI. A member cannot apply for both Orations of IRIA and ICRI at the same time. Also, if a member has got one Oration from IRIA or ICRI in past, then he/she cannot apply for the second time again.
