Eligibility Guidelines and Requirements for Orations of ICRI

ELIGIBILITY:

- The applicant should be a Life member of both IRIA and ICRI for Orations of ICRI.
- Applications for ICRI Orations should be proposed & seconded by ICRI Members.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. The title and abstract of Oration should be submitted along with application.
- 2. The application must be proposed and seconded by members of ICRI for ICRI Orations.
- 3. The work presented should be personal contribution of the applicant preferably done in India.
- 4. The subject of the Oration should not have been published or presented elsewhere.
- 5. The application should be submitted within the time limit (on or before 30th September) through an online portal along with all necessary documents as proof.
- 6. The Oration shall not exceed 30 minutes reading time.
- 7. The ICRI Oration shall be held on 1st day of the Annual Conference.
- 8. As per constitution, a member can apply for one Oration at one time, either in IRIA or in ICRI. A member cannot apply for both Orations of IRIA and ICRI at the same time. Also, if a member has got one Oration from IRIA or ICRI in past, then he/she cannot apply for the second time again.
