## Eligibility Guidelines and Requirements for Orations of ICRI

### ELIGIBILITY:

- The applicant should be a Life member of both IRIA and ICRI for Orations of ICRI.
- Applications for ICRI Orations should be proposed & seconded by ICRI Members.

### REQUIREMENTS:

1. The title and abstract of Oration should be submitted along with application.
2. The application must be proposed and seconded by members of ICRI for ICRI Orations.
3. The work presented should be personal contribution of the applicant preferably done in India.
4. The subject of the Oration should not have been published or presented elsewhere.
5. The application should be submitted within the time limit (on or before 30<sup>th</sup> September) through an online portal along with all necessary documents as proof.
6. The Oration shall not exceed 30 minutes reading time.
7. The ICRI Oration shall be held on 1st day of the Annual Conference.
8. As per constitution, a member can apply for one Oration at one time, either in IRIA or in ICRI. A member cannot apply for both Orations of IRIA and ICRI at the same time. Also, if a member has got one Oration from IRIA or ICRI in past, then he/she cannot apply for the second time again.
